

TECHNICAL REGULATIONS;

5.1 INTRODUCTION

The following technical regulations are set out in accordance with the Motorsport UK. specified format and it should be clearly understood that if the following texts do not clearly specify that you can do it, you should work on the principal that you cannot. Competitors are advised to read the following sections of the Motorsport UK Yearbook Regulations. Motorsport UK Regulations. Sections (J.4.1 to J.5.20.13). Section Q. Motorsport UK Regulations. Section B. Nomenclature & Definitions. Section K – Section L and relevant Formula Ford 1600 Technical Regulations for the age of the car issued by the Ford Motor Company specifically and published by BRSCC. See Appendix 2

5.2 GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The Northern Ireland Formula Ford 1600 Championship is for competitors participating in cars complying with regulations for Club F.F.1600 as published by the Ford Motor Company, Boreham Airfield, Essex CM3 3BG, and the BRSCC and incorporating amendments made for 2009-2023

Overall: For all cars complying with current FMC FF1600 regulations,
There will be three categories:

Class A: For cars built after January 1st 1990

Class B: For cars built after January 1st 1983 but before December 31 1989

Class C: For cars built before December 31 1982

5.3 SAFETY

All Motorsport UK. Section K safety criteria regulations apply as relevant. Particularly competitors should note; (the following are mandatory requirements)

K1	Roll bar
K2	Seatbelts – 6 Point
K3	Fire extinguisher.
K5	Rear Light
K6	Tank Fillers, Vents and Caps
K8	Circuit breaker
K9	Overalls
K10	Helmet
K11	Goggles or visor
K12	Propeller Shaft Restraint
K13	Head restraint.
K14	Fuel Tank

Please note regulations in Section J and specifically J5.2.1

In addition, competitors are reminded that Yearbook regulations Section J apply.

The wearing of the following flame resistant racewear is mandatory for this championship K14 ie. gloves, balaclava, socks or shoes. The wearing of flame resistant underwear is recommended.

1. Competitors are restricted to five (5) full car sets of tyres during the Championship.
2. The use of tyre heating/heat retention devices, tyre treatments and compounds is prohibited.
3. Competitors in Class D (Pre-1982) cars will be permitted to use Avon ACB9 tyres.

5.14 WEIGHTS; As per current yearbook and current FMC Club FF1600 regulations .

- 1 Minimum Weight of car in race ready condition to be no less than 420kg
- 2 Minimum weight of car in race ready condition with driver to be no less than 500kg

5.15 FUEL TANK/FUEL; As per current Motorsport UK yearbook and current FMC Club FF1600 regulations

5.16 SILENCING; As per current yearbook and current Club FMC FF1600 regulations
