STARTING ORDER IS DETERMINED BY CLASS. DRIVERS MUST PROCEED TO START LINE WHEN INSTRUCTED (S 9.4)).

As things have more or less returned to 'normal' Scrutineering will once again be held in the Scrutiny Bay at the Hairpin end of the Paddock. Once you have passed scrutiny, bring your scrutiny form at the office on the ground floor of the Control Tower, bringing with you your competition licence. Drivers who have not previously competed at a 500 MRCI Sprint **MUST** report to the Clerk of Course on arrival.

Your relevant Club Membership Card **MUST** be produced at signing on (ie 500 MRCI or any MSUK affiliated club).

Prize giving for each class will be held, after the event, at the base of the control tower..

Please park neatly in the paddock or as directed.

You are reminded that your vehicle **MUST** be fitted with a timing strut in accordance with S 10.10. Failure to comply may result in the vehicle not being timed.

Good luck, have a good day's sport and please leave the circuit clean and tidy.

The 500 MRCI reserve the right to alter, amend or change these Regulations with regard to: Classes, Awards, Laps, Entry Fees, Times and Named Officials.

The 500 MRCI also reserve the right to refuse an entry from any driver who by his actions on any circuit brings, in the opinion of the Club, the sport into disrepute. In addition, any competitor, or team member (being any person recognised as being an associate of that competitor) whose behaviour at any circuit is deemed to be unreasonable, may face sanctions as laid down by the Club and Motorsport UK.

NOTICE: Should you have to discard waste oil, please use the green tank located at the exit gate from Paddock to pit lane. Do **NOT** dump oil in the blue pins located elsewhere in the Paddock.

IMPORTANT : We would draw your attention to the **2024 ANICC Sprint regulations (attached)** with particular reference to class eligibility. In other words **Make Sure You have entered the correct class !**
